## SYNOPSIS

**bash\_avpres**

## DESCRIPTION

**Bash\_AVpres** is a collection of Bash scripts for audio-visual preservation. One of these small programs is **bash\_avpres** which lists the installed commands provided by the set.

## NOTES

**Bash\_AVpres** has been tested for Bash version 3.2 or higher and version 4.3 or later is recommended for the **metadata\_csv** and **name\_hash** scripts. However, we strongly recommend that you use the current version 5.3.

**Bash\_AVpres** has been successfully tested on modern x86-64 and AArch64 architectures, running the following operating systems:

**Linux:** Debian 13.3, 12.13 und 11.11; Ubuntu 25.10, 24.04.3 LTS and 22.04.5 LTS

**Macintosh:** macOS 26.2, 15.7.3 and 14.8.3

**Windows 11** version 25H2, 24H2 and 23H2 running Subsystem for Linux (WSL 2.6.3)

## LOG FILES

Temporary log files are stored at  
/tmp/AVpres/bash\_avpres.XXXXXXXXXX

The log files can be used for debugging:

**cat /tmp/AVpres/bash\_avpres.XXXXXXXXXX**
